Changemaker High School will be closed to students on Thursday, April 26 and Friday, April 27. All afterschool programs are hereby cancelled. Due to the school closure, the school year will have to be extended by two days minimum. If the #REDFORED walkout continues long-term, the school's leadership will find ways to best handle the situation and we will keep you updated with all relevant information.

Please be reassured that at this point the dates for our end of year student exhibition and graduation ceremony will remain the same. We are committed to working with all students and families so that their hard work for the school year is honored and that graduating seniors receive the recognition that they deserve.

For families that would like to come into the school, so their child can receive breakfast starting at 8:00AM and/or lunch starting at 12:30PM, please call the school so we can have a meal ready for your child. Any parent or family member who would like to receive a meal can also request a meal and can make arrangements for payment with the front office. Students who are interested in receiving a meal should be accompanied by a parent or guardian because staff supervision will not be available.

Please know that Changemaker High School is committed to your child's education and would in no way want to create an unsupervised or unsafe learning environment. The decision to close the school is not taken lightly and we encourage your feedback and/or questions regarding the matter.

If any additional or new information becomes available, parents and guardians will receive a phone call and/or email (if provided to the school). This information will also be shared on the school website as well as at the school site and updates will be made continuously on social media (Facebook) and via our text messenger system. Be assured that we will do everything we can to provide you with as much information as possible.
